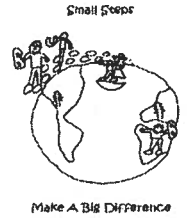

Sibling Relationship Issues-When One Sib Has Special Needs - Presented by Leslie Vasquez, former Program Coordinator for Health Related Services at Parents Helping Parents. 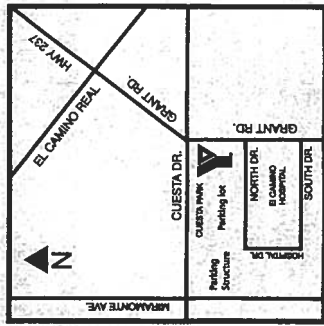

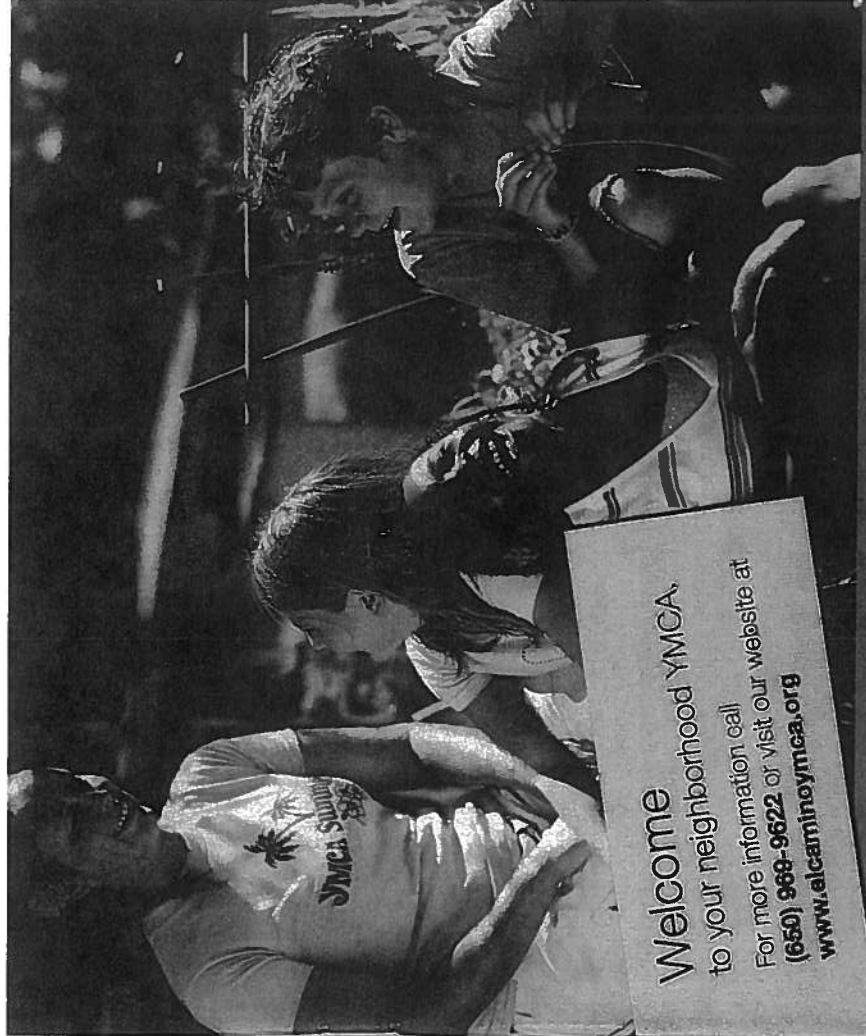
